Description	<p>The mechanically governed 3406C propulsion engine is scheduled to resume production in the next few months with an available “A” rating of 365 bhp (272 bkW) and a “B” rating of 400 bhp (298 bkW).</p> <p>Production is targeted for late 2013 in the Caterpillar India - Hosur facility.</p>
Features/Benefits	<p>This platform will provide propulsion power for markets in lesser regulated countries and will also introduce Cat products to new customers who may in the future require products that meet higher emissions regulations.</p> <p>At first production the 3406C propulsion engine will not be emissions compliant (non-Emissions compliant) and will not be able to be certified for MCS (non-MCS approved).</p> <p>The engine consist will resemble the previous offering, but certain components will be sourced from local suppliers where applicable.</p>
Availability	The order board is targeted to open in November 2013. A revision to this Product News will be distributed to communicate open order board.
Pricing Information	A new price list will be created for this product.
General Comments	NPI updates on the 3406C re-introduction, provided by the Product Definition group, are scheduled for October 22 and 23.
